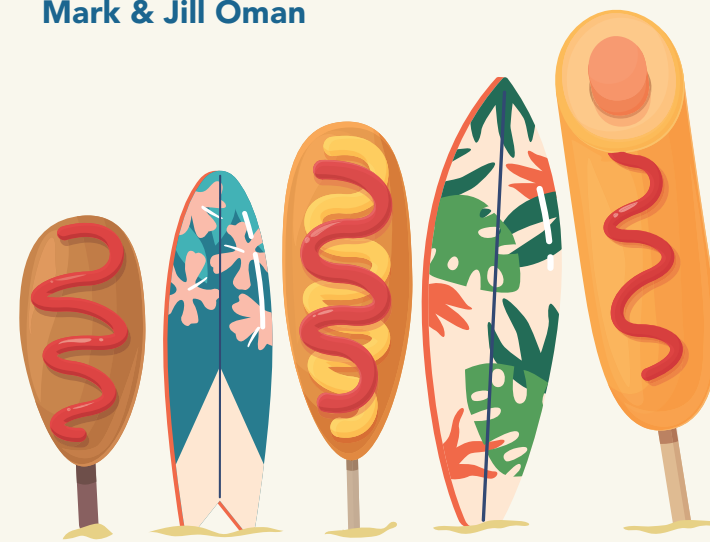

More about the documentary:

"Our Great State Fair" explores the history of Iowa's biggest event – the annual showcase of our state's best in agriculture, industry, entertainment and achievement. The story begins in 1854, as an experimental agricultural exposition in Fairfield, and continues into the 21st century as a statewide celebration in Des Moines.

The Iowa State Fair is the culmination of everything Iowa is known for: a social event, a livestock show, a competition stage, an entertainment venue, a political platform and a classroom. It's a place to experience Iowa's past and at the same time, look towards its future. "Our Great State Fair" dives into the stories that set it apart from any other fair, and shows how the event brings people together for eleven unforgettable days each year.

FOUNDATION NEWS

Since its inception in 1993, the **Blue Ribbon Foundation** has been raising funds to maintain and improve the historic Iowa State Fairgrounds. You'll see many projects at this year's Iowa State Fair.

The \$25 million livestock barns renovation project started in the **Sheep Barn** and included multiple components – restoring brick and terra cotta masonry, remodeling the office area and restrooms, installing new underground storm sewer piping, reroofing all lower level roof areas, adding new restrooms, repainting, and providing a sun-shade for the show arena.

The Iowa State Fair **public safety building** was updated to make sure the facility meets the needs and high standards of the Iowa State Fair Police Department. The first phase included a new 2-story addition to the east side of the building. The second phase will include renovation of the existing space, scheduled to be completed in 2024.

Fairgoers will enjoy sipping on a wide selection of beers and wine while relaxing on top of the hill near Grandfather's Barn at the **Fairview Tap**. The venue received upgrades including a patio expansion. This addition will provide more outside seating to take full advantage of the available space and the amazing view.

Pioneer Hall continually receives maintenance and after 10 years of small updates, the exterior of the building is near completion. Crews have finished repairing each side of the building and will complete the project by rebuilding the main doors.

The north and east exterior doors of the **Agriculture Building** have been renovated. Each custom door is engineered for function and longevity, following accessibility guidelines. The new doors will enable better security and provide weather-proofing to fix previous issues of large gaps and easy-to-pop locks.

Be sure to attend the events at the **Elwell Family Park** during this year's Iowa State Fair. The 3rd stage of the multi-phase project adds permanent restroom facilities. These restrooms will be a convenient upgrade for Fairgoers watching the fast-paced and pure adrenaline events.

The Iowa State Fair is a tradition any Iowan can be proud of and the Blue Ribbon Foundation is dedicated to continuing that legacy. Thank you for your support.

PAYMENT AND SALE CONDITIONS

1. Payment for all items purchased by the final bidder must be made at the conclusion of the auction event or before the bidder leaves the auction.
 2. There will be two options available for payment.

 - b. Payment may also be initiated through your user profile on the GiveSmart application.

 4. Buyers claim items by presenting a paid auction receipt to a silent or live auction assistant.

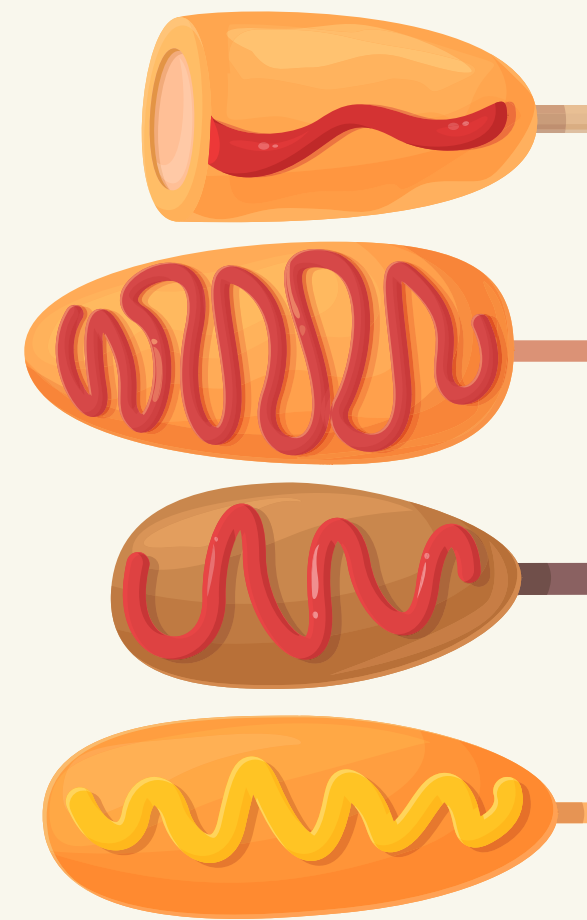

Silent Auction

Bidding on the silent auction will be through the GiveSmart mobile bidding application. A link to the event page for the auction can be found at www.BlueRibbonFoundation.org or use the QR Code.



1. To bid, you must register as a bidder on the app and provide the required information, including a valid credit card number. You can view auction packages without signing up as a bidder.
2. The silent auction will open for bidding at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, July 7. Bidding will close at 8:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 8.
3. You do not need to be present at the event in order to bid on a silent auction package.
4. All packages will be on display at the event for attendees to view.
5. All bidders on items containing alcohol or gift certificates for alcohol must be 21 years of age or older. These items must be picked up by someone 21 years of age or older.

Live Auction

1. The live auction begins at 8:00 p.m. and concludes when all items have been sold.
2. To bid, you will need to register for a bid number at the bid card registration table in advance of the live auction. All bidders must have an assigned bidder number.
3. Each live auction package has a number. The auctioneer announces the package number and gives a brief description of the items in the package.
4. To bid on a package, please raise your bid number for acknowledgment by the auctioneer or ringmen.
5. The auctioneer will announce the final bid amount and buyer.
