## 2026 Projects:

- Grandstand roof replacement (Phase I)
- New entrance to Lot C (University Avenue and East 38th Street)
- A \$2.5 million renovation of the William C. Knapp Varied Industries Building includes concessions kitchen upgrades, new second-floor window coverings, new flooring in the conference rooms, south hallway, and southeast lobby, as well as a renovation of the southwest restroom
- Installation of new fans in the Outdoor Arena
- New street signs throughout the Fairgrounds and Campgrounds
- Cookie Building HVAC improvements
- Agriculture Building roof replacement

- Additional ADA seating in the Grandstand
- 4-H Exhibit Building display fixture replacement (Phase II)
- New shaded seating area east of the Cookie Building
- New doors for the Agriculture Building (Phase II)
- Grounds-wide public address (PA) system for emergency announcements (Phase II)
- Campgrounds Restroom #4 renovation (Phase II)
- New show ring and portable pens in the Sheep Barn
- Lot N improvements (concessionaire supply area)

**Horse Barn** — Phase II includes installation of concrete floor with radiant heat, relocated offices, added interior wash rack area, portable stalls, fire suppression system and enhanced ventilation throughout the facility.

**Cattle Barn** — Phase I includes the construction of a new electrical distribution building on the north side that will include space for new electrical equipment, electrical storage and maintenance storage.

**Swine Barn** — Phase I involves the remodeling of the west office, west women's restroom and the construction of new restrooms on the east end of the Barn (men's, women's and family).

## Silent Auction

Bidding on the silent auction will be through GiveSmart. A link to the event page for the auction can be found at [www.BlueRibbonFoundation.org](http://www.BlueRibbonFoundation.org) or by using the QR code.

1. To bid, you must register as a bidder and provide the required information, including a valid credit card number. You can view auction packages without signing up as a bidder.

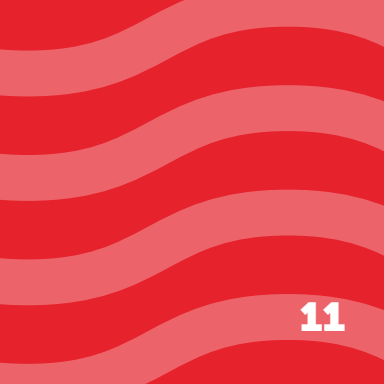
