
So, bring your kids and grandkids to the Iowa State Fair. Let them feel the pride and connection of our shared community. Hopefully it will stay with them for a lifetime.

This 7"x7" limited edition wood plaque, created by Sticks, is a jubilant reflection of a century-long love affair with the fiddle.

Lapel Pin: Nestled on the hillside between the Cultural Center and Youth Inn, Hillcrest Dorm was constructed in 1930. Recent renovations including a new roof, ventilation system, windows and restrooms were a warm welcome from the FFA members who stay in the building while serving as Grandstand ushers.

Charms: Artists create their best pieces for submission in the Fine Arts competition at the Iowa State Fair. Display this painter's palette on your charm bracelet along with the 2025 "Fair Sweet Fair" logo charm.

Ornament: Each year, more than 900 exhibitors show 3,700 sheep during the Iowa State Fair. The club lamb is represented in this year's ornament, but all 16 breeds are showcased with pride.

Isabel Bloom Sculpture: Historic barns are scattered throughout Iowa, symbolizing our rich agricultural heritage and farming traditions. This red barn ornament is a tribute to both the iconic barns of the Iowa State Fair and the beloved barns found on farms across the state.

Butter Cow Necklace & Bracelet: The Butter Cow resides in the Agriculture Building. Add a miniature version to your jewelry collection with this corded necklace and bracelet.

Sticks Ornament: On a stick or in a cup, nothing compares to Iowa State Fair food — so let's eat up! This ornament shows the deliciousness of the Fair.

Project Update

Horse Barn: Phase One of the project (exterior painting, window replacement, masonry repairs and north restroom renovation and construction) will be completed prior to the 2025 Iowa State Fair. Phase Two (concrete floor with radiant heat, relocated offices, interior wash rack area, portable stalls, fire suppression system and enhanced ventilation) will begin this fall and be finished in time for the 2026 Fair.

Ron & Bev Shivers Family Plaza: Thank you to the Shivers Family for their generous donation to create a beautiful plaza. The project features open seating, landscaping and brand-new restrooms.
